The Eucharistic Congress 2012 is a holy event of the 50th International Eucharistic Congress. From its origins in the Eucharistic Congress of 1934, the Congress has been more recently used to mark the 50th anniversary of the Second Vatican Council. The Bell will reflect the faith and the love of the people of the Diocese of Dromore who have always been important as our Christian brothers and sisters. It is a great privilege to be part of the pilgrimage of the Bell through the Diocese of Dromore, and beyond, and we will be a welcome to all people to share their journey with Christ and with one another.

The journey through the Diocese will begin in Lurgan and end in Rathfriland. From there the Bell will be handed over to the Diocese of Cavan and Fermanagh. It will arrive in each parish between 1.00 pm and 6.00 pm and be carried by volunteers to the church where there will be services of reflection on the Bell.

The girl on this year's Tricentennial box is Diana Portillo Amador. She is five years old and lives with her family in north east Dromore, in a small community called La Confianza. The community is extremely poor. Families work together to farm the land and earn an income. However, yields are so low that they barely make enough to pay for basic necessities like food and clothing. People have been forced off their land time and time again by wealthy landowners who carry out violent attacks on vulnerable communities. Diana's family has endured difficult and bitter poor years. Her father, Carlos, is one of many fathers who have struggled to provide for their families. Carlos doesn't know how they managed to survive on so little for so long. Please help families like this and give as generous as you can. Thank you for all your support.
