Appeal for Laurencetown Church

Appeal for Laurencetown Church

When we look at the church in Laurencetown and its deteriorating condition we need to look back at its history and the great personal difficulties Cubolice of this erae had in building at From the Rebellion of 1614 through the Cromwellian Period (1604-1604) and following the passing of the Penal laws 1693-1697 Catholice in this parish attended mass at "Mass Rocks" in sechuded places at 1760 Mount, Chre, Bleany, Newmills and Knockangore. Tradition tells how the Catholic people of the district were assembling for Mass in the open air at the Mass Rock at 1760 Mount on a cold winter morning with more occurring the ground whem Laurence (after whom Lawrencedown is called), his wife and daughter observed this pathetic sight. His daughter, feeling sonry for the hardships to which Catholics were exposed saked for flather to do something for them. When asked what he was expected to do she staggested that they should be given the "old flatling or threshing house" located just where we are now near the bridge. The request was duly granted. Then from about 1750 this building was recognised by all creeds as "Roman Catholic Chaped."

After 1771, Catholics could late out leases on property, so on 12²⁰ April 1790, Pr. Hugh O'Kelly late to become Bishop of Dromore, secured a lease on the present Charch sith here in Coose, Laurencetown. The Parish had now legal ownership of a church and centerly.
